



Winter Inferencing Questions




Instructions

What might the people be doing together that we can't see?

What do you think she will need to do before she can safely drive away?
How could the ice affect her driving, and why?
How do you think she feels?

Why do you think his tongue is stuck to the pole?
What might happen next, and why?

5

Where do you think the man is?
Why do you think the man is walking toward the cabin instead of staying outside?
What do you think he plans to do once he gets to the cabin?

6

What clues tell you what activity they are about to do?
Why are they sitting down?

7

Why do you think she is blowing on the oatmeal?
What might happen if she eats it without blowing on it first?

8

What might the tissue tell you about how she is feeling?
What could happen if she stays outside too long in this weather?

9

What do you think someone is planning to make with these ingredients?
Why do you think people might want to make hot chocolate during winter?

10

Why do you think the snowman is leaning or tilting?
What clues tell you about the weather or ground where the snowman is built?

11

Why do you think the plane is not taking off?
How might the woman be feeling while waiting, and why?
What do you think she might do next because of the snow delay?

How do you think the mom and child feel as they go down the hill?
What might happen after they reach the bottom of the hill?
